As you know, the great purpose of this trade skills to furnish with these youths with some practical knowledge where they can offer services to the public as a way of earning a living and become self reliable and to also a sources of support to the other suffering children in the communities around.

- 2 - **Leather work (Shoe making)**
- 3 - **Sewing (Dealing with Yarn)**
- 4 - **Embroidery (Fabric decorations).**
- 5 - **Carpentry & Joinery**
- 6 - **Dressmaking**
- 7 - **Cookery and Baking**

We also have other trades that our children are training at such as:

- 9 - **Masonry Building & Plumbing,**
- 10 - **Painting and Artistic work.**
- 11 - **Automobile and Vehicle mechanics,**
- 12 - **Fashion and designing.**
