They have been distributing widely many thousands of literatures to the needy hungry souls in the remote villages, city streets and in the slums of Kenya. ### Our Soon coming Vocational School:

In this New Year 2012, we are going to lay down the new foundation of the vocation Trade school and the High school section to our soon graduating orphans from this home. You are very much aware that these children have come out from very poor backgrounds of lives, and it could be just a waste of time to have them here for years and that after their life here in home, send them away with no practical skill to earn them a living. Our goal is to make a total difference and a complete turnaround on their moral, spiritual and physical lives. So, for them to be self sustainable in their future life, they practically need various skills like, [Carpentry](#), [Knitting](#), [Masonry](#), [Farming](#), [leather work](#), [Computer](#), [Cookery](#) and [Medical missionary](#) and others.



Already now, we have 10 youths nearing to leave the home in only two years; we are in so much need now to start the construction of this school before time passes by, this is our current and the most very urgent need for the Mission. We know our help comes from the Lord, no doubt about that, but through you.

We are starting with one section at a time and as the Lord will supply the funds, then the rest will follow on section by section, the first section, I mean the first slabs block with almost 10 good spacious rooms will require a minimum of \$ 50,000.00. Already we have received, \$ 5,000 our faithful supporters, bringing our figure down to \$ 45,000.00, I believe the Lord will speak to your heart also and make this figure to zero, and that as you read this, please give what you may have for this project, you may not know how God is going to work through your donation towards this project. **Miriam**

Miriam is one of our primary teachers here in the mission. We employed her since the inception of the home in the year 2003; we took her first as a grade one teacher, before we later learnt that she was an HIV positive which was infected to her, by her former addicted drunkard husband. Miriam is a very strong woman in her morals standards; she is very faithful Christian woman.



In the year 2007, Miriam's husband died of the HIV AIDS disease, and then we officially took all her three children to the home as orphans. Jane now 17, Beth 15 and John 14, these are also very beautiful children and bright in school, Jane the elder daughter to Miriam is in the third year high school here at Fiwagoh, she is hoping to be a nurse after her University level.

In the year 2008, Miriam almost died of the same disease simply because of the trauma she got after losing beloved husband, we took her as our own sister and cared for her since all the family members abandoned her as a hopeless woman, but we did not give up even after she was tested of her CD4 Counts and was found with only 50. Then her Dr. in that Mission Hospital called me in a private room assured me that she was going to die soon. So we her took her home and kept on praying while Florence was making lots raw juices of both fresh vegetables and fruits for her, and indeed finally God did a miracle on her life, only after a few months later, Miriam shocked everyone when she regained back to her health again, though she still lives with the HIV AIDS, we give back the Glory to God for what He has done to this lovely woman. It is a miracle to have Miriam still surviving and living in the Lord and serving Him in faithfulness till today. In her latest VIRO-LOADS Test, she was found having only 1700 from 3400. She has been doing very well and she still works at Fiwagoh as a grade one teacher. The salary we pay her every month is not so enough to help her purchase enough fruits and vegetables,

which saved her life and it is ever a requirement in her diet, we thought to make this one a public notice to our supporters and donors around the world, that she is in need of extra support of \$ 150.00 every month to enable her get good nutritional foods and supplies to keep her health fit. If you may have anyone in mind or may be yourself, would like to give this support to a faithful mother, teacher and Bible worker in the Fiwagoh home, please feel free to send your donation earmarked as **Miriam's Support**, her and us all, will be very grateful indeed. Once you have made the decision to support Miriam on monthly basis, we will also give you her e-mail or postal contacts so that you may keep in touch with her directly and regularly. **Visit to the Fiwagoh Mission:**

But we would like to make it so clear that any volunteer coming to help the mission is supposed to **pay \$ 50.00 per a week, this fee is for food and for the clean drinking water, A visitor coming only to stay, will pay \$ 100.00 per one week, this fees includes food, and accommodation and clean water.** Our Mission has been greatly encouraged by the visitors who are coming through our gates with cheering words, and various gifts and donations as well, which really make us feel that we are part of a big family in the world. Those who want to give gifts to the children, please always kindly inquire from us first before you go on to buy something, but all letters, birth day cards to the children can be written and addressed to our Mission postal address. We also ensure that you get your replies ASAP as the child or someone writes back to you. Volunteers with special skills like Carpentry, Masonry Dressmaking, Teaching, Nursing, Leatherwork, Computer s and others are needed now than ever before as we are almost starting our trade school college.
